Receiving HOLY EUCHARIST

Holy Eucharist – Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Holy Communion) – is one of the seven Sacraments. It has to be received worthily for the salvation of our soul. Holy Eucharist is not just representation of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ but after the Consecration becomes the **Body and Blood of Jesus Christ**. When preparing ourselves for the receiving of the Holy Eucharist we should examine our conscience and make sure if we do not have any mortal sins. (In case of mortal sin we need to have the Sacrament of Confession). Make act of contrition for all your venial sins and then with reverence receive Holy Eucharist.

Guidelines for Great Lent

Abstinence from meat and dairy products should be observed on the first day of Lent and Good Friday. Abstinence from meat should be observed on all Friday of the Great Lent and is suggested and encouraged to be observed on all Wednesdays of the Great Lent (For more detailed information regarding Great Lent please refer to the regulations of the Stamford Eparchy)

In March

15th – Veneration of the Cross

18th of March Mid Lent

25th – Annunciation of the Theotokos – solemn feast

Prayer of St. Ephrem

O Lord and Master of my life, drive from me the spirit of indifference, despair, lust for power and idle chatter. **(prostration)**

Instead, bestow on me, Your servant, the spirit of integrity, humility, patience and love. **(Prostration)**
