Sacraments

Those who wish to receive Sacrament of First Holy Communion or Marriage, please talk to the priest at least 6 months prior to the event.

Receiving HOLY EUCHARIST

Holy Eucharist – Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Holy Communion) – is one of the seven Sacraments. It has to be received worthily for the salvation of our soul. Holy Eucharist is not just representation of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ but after the Consecration becomes the **Body and Blood of Jesus Christ**. When preparing ourselves for the receiving of the Holy Eucharist we should examine our conscience and make sure if we do not have any mortal sins. (In case of mortal sin we need to have the Sacrament of Confession). Make act of contrition for all your venial sins and then with reverence receive Holy Eucharist.

Abstinence from meat should be observed on all Friday of the Great Lent and is suggested and encouraged to be observed on all Wednesdays of the Great Lent (For detailed information regarding Lent please refer to the regulations of the Stamford Eparchy)

24th – Veneration of the Holy Cross (Sunday)

25th – Feast of Anunciation of the Theotokos
